



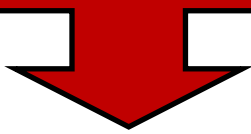

What Is Title 3?

Title 3 is a federally mandated and funded program for students who speak languages other than English in the home.



How are students identified for Title 3 Services?

Home language surveys submitted at the start of the school year determine who receives Title 3 services.



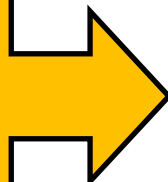
Who Receives Title 3 Services?

Exchange students and students who indicate a language other than English is spoken in the home are automatically screened and enrolled in the program.



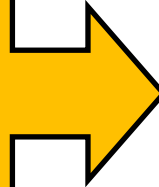
What Is WIDA?

WIDA is a national test used to evaluate the progress of student language learning in the four domains of: Speaking, Reading, Writing, and Listening.



What Is WIDA Progress Monitoring?

Progress monitoring is a brief assessment used to monitor the progress of student language learning in the four domains of: Speaking, Reading, Writing, and Listening.



When Are Testing Results Returned?

Testing results are returned to schools and families in the summer months of July or August.



When Does WIDA Testing Take Place?

WIDA testing takes place in Michigan for Title 3 students in February and March of each year. Students in Kindergarten through 12th grade participate in the test.



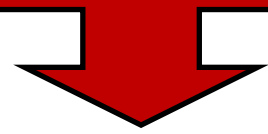
Who Uses the WIDA Test?

The WIDA test is used in 42 states across the nation. It is also used globally in additional territories and countries.



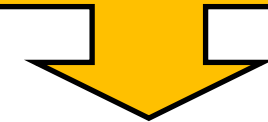
When Does Manchester Progress Monitor with WIDA?

Students are progress monitored four times a year: Twice in the fall, once in the winter, and again in the spring.



Why Does Manchester Progress Monitor?

Results from monitoring are used to help personalize instruction in the four domains of language development.



Does Monitoring Help Prepare Students for the WIDA Test?

Through this practice, the students become more comfortable with the format of the actual test before they take the test in February/March.
